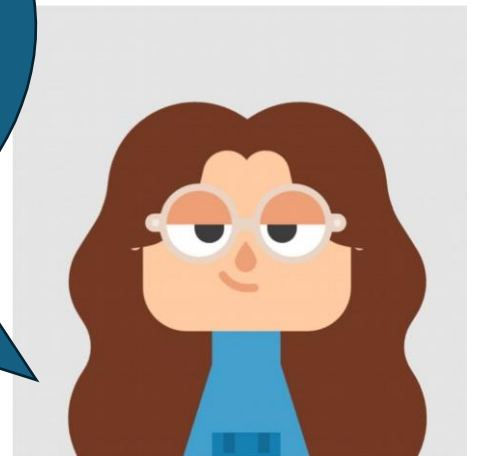
Democracy is a system of government by the whole population or all the eligible members of a state, typically through elected representatives. So it is to choose a representative that will be the voice of the people .



In France, France's first democratic republic dates from October 4, 1958. The first president of French democracy was Charles de Gaulle in 1959.

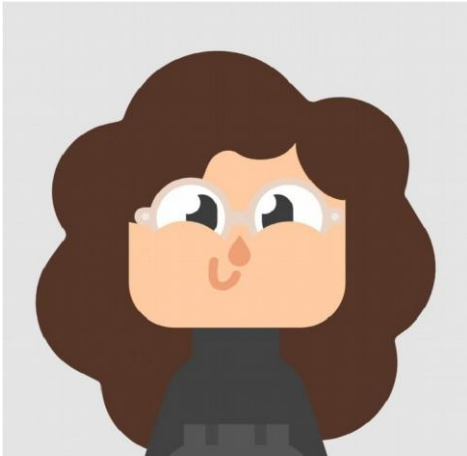


And now this is Participatory democracy citizens' involvement in public decision-making, notably through associations.



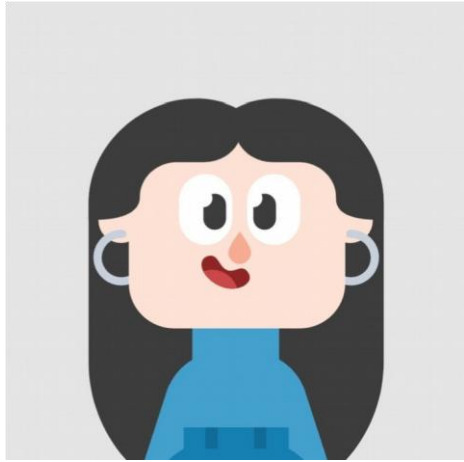


In Türkiye, the democracy started in 1923 . And Türkiye's first president was Mustafa Kemal Atatürk.



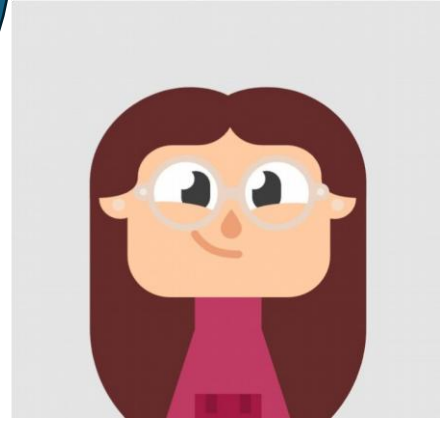
In Latvia, the democracy started in 1920. And Latvia's first president was Janis Cakste.





In the first article of Italian Constitution it's written that Italy is a democratic republic founded on work and that sovereignty belongs to people...

...It was born with the Referendum of 2 July 1946 when monarchy was abolished and a Constituent Assembly was elected. The first president was Enrico De Nicola.
