#### **Legend of our flag**


A Latgalian leader was wounded in battle, and sheet on which he was laid on were stained by his blood with only the centre stripe of the sheet being left unstained




One of the fastest internet speeds in the world

Around 20% of Latvia's territory is protected.






## Latvia has 12,000 rivers and 3,000 small lakes




# Around 54% of Latvia is forest, making it one of Europe's greenest countries



Latvia produces more female models per capital than almost any country in the world.









Latvia's current flag design has been in use since 1280. Only Denmark's has been around longer.

## Celebrations



### Song and dance festival

- The Latvian Song Festival has been held since 1873, normally every five years
- The Latvian Song and Dance Festival is one of the largest and important choral and dancing events in Latvian culture.
- Approximately 40,000 performers altogether participate





### Jāņi (Summer solstice)

- Night from June 23 to June 24.
- Wild flowers picked on summer solstice are believed to have healing powers.
- Homes are decorated and women weave wildflower crowns.
- Many traditions, including leaping over the bonfire.
- Sleeping is only allowed after sunrise.









### Ziemas saulgrieži (Winter solstice)

- "Ziemassvētki" or Christmas in Latvia is a mix of ethnic, religious and modern traditions.
- Rīga is recognised as the birthplace of the first Christmas tree in 1510 by some accounts.
- Traditional dishes are served at Christmas (Christmas roast and gingerbread cookies)








### Name days

- Marked in the calendar.
- Each day includes up to four names.
- May 22 day to celebrate the names not included in it.
- Customary that anyone can join a name-day party without an invitation.





### Educational system

- Start school at the age of 7.
- Grading scale from 1(the lowest) to 10.
- In high school(10th to 12th grade), an average of 17 different subjects in total.
- Length of each class 40 minutes.
- We learn English, German, Spanish, France and Russian as our foreign languages.
