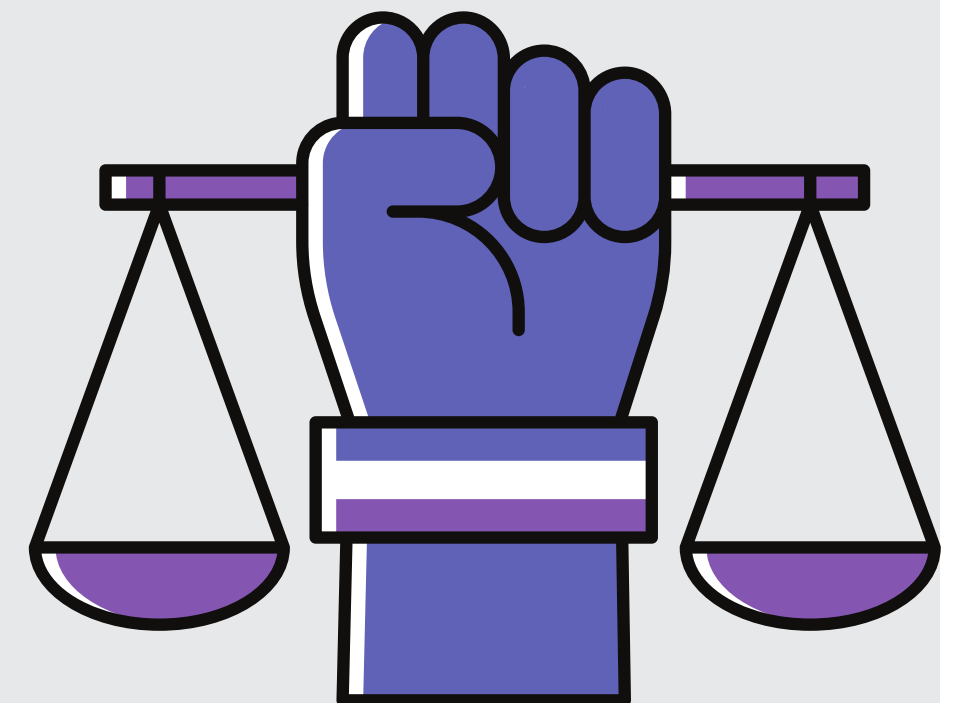

- *These rights ensure everyone can live with dignity, equality, and freedom.*
