Daugavpils Draudzīgā aicinājuma Secondary School is a comprehensive educational institution with its administration located at 40 Aveņu Street, Daugavpils.

The educational institution was established in 2022 by combining Daugavpils 16th secondary school, Daugavpils 17th secondary school, Daugavpils 7th preschool educational institution, Daugavpils 5th preschool educational institution and Daugavpils 3rd preschool educational institution.

In September 2023, 1772 pupils (1197 in general secondary education programmes, 575 in pre-school education programmes) started their studies at Daugavpils Draudziga aicinajuma Secondary School.

The learning process takes place in 5 buildings The director of the school is Kristina Ivancova.






